EXCEPTIONAL PEOPLE CATEGORY:

This award will recognise the courage and commitment of members of the public who have either directly tackled anti-social behaviour or neighbourhood crime or who have supported others to do so.

WONDERFUL WORKER CATEGORY:

Trained Community Crime Fighters are invited to nominate a paid worker from one of their local services who they feel has provided an exceptional level of support to them or someone in their neighbourhood. This worker will be someone who has gone 'above and beyond' to support them or others.
